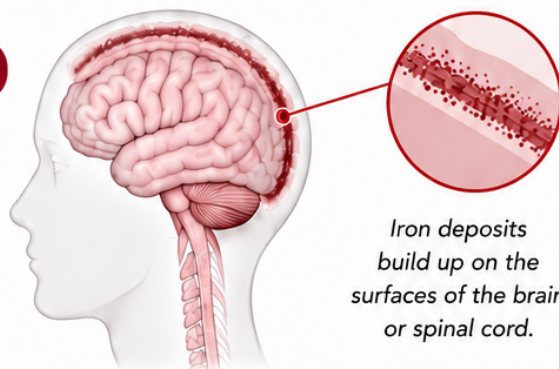

WHAT IS SUPERFICIAL SIDEROSIS?

A neurological condition in which repeated bleeding into the surfaces of the brain or spinal cord leads to deposits of iron (hemosiderin), damaging tissue over time.



Iron deposits build up on the surfaces of the brain or spinal cord.
